Parents / Carers or individual students have the right to refuse or withdraw consent temporarily or permanently for any of the above, at any time by contacting the Head of Year or emailing the School at: contactus@rooksheath.harrow.sch.uk

Where consent is declined for using biometric systems the School has a duty to provide reasonable alternative arrangements for a student to access the school lunch and Library services.

Parents / Carers may be asked to contribute towards any lost or damaged items borrowed from the Library or for any deliberate damage to ICT equipment or any other school property.
