

### Rooks Heath Sixth Form: Minimum Entry Requirements

To study **A levels** you need to achieve a minimum of 6 GCSEs at Grades 9-5 (or C and above) including both Maths and English Language.

The following A level subjects have specific entry requirements which you must achieve if you are to study them.

| <b>A level subject</b>    | <b>Specific requirements</b>  |
|---------------------------|---|
| <b>Maths</b>              | A minimum of grade 6 at GCSE Maths  |
| <b>Further Maths</b>      | A minimum of grade 7 at GCSE Maths  |
| <b>Biology</b>            | A minimum of grades 665 at GCSE Triple Science (with at least a 6 in Biology) or a minimum of 66 in GCSE Combined Science   |
| <b>Chemistry</b>          | A minimum of grades 665 at GCSE Triple Science (with at least a 6 in Chemistry) and a minimum of 66 in GCSE Combined Science  |
| <b>Physics</b>            | A minimum of grades 665 at GCSE Triple Science (with at least a 6 in Physics) or a minimum of 66 in GCSE Combined Science <b>and</b> a minimum of a grade 6 at GCSE Maths. Students will also need to study A level maths |
| <b>Computer Science</b>   | A minimum of a grade 6 at Maths and it would be desirable to have at least a 6 grade at GCSE Computer Science   |
| <b>Psychology</b>         | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in a GCSE Science and at least a 5 grade if students have sat GCSE Psychology   |
| <b>French</b>             | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in GCSE French  |
| <b>German</b>             | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in GCSE German  |
| <b>Latin</b>              | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in GCSE Latin   |
| <b>Ancient Greek</b>      | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in GCSE Ancient Greek   |
| <b>English Literature</b> | A minimum of grades 6 in both GCSE English Language and GCSE English Literature   |
| <b>Business Studies</b>   | A minimum of a Merit for students who studied BTEC level 2 Business Studies   |
| <b>Sport and PE</b>       | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in GCSE PE  |
| <b>History</b>            | A minimum of at least a grade 5 in GCSE History   |

There are no specific subject entry requirements for the following A level subjects: Economics, Film Studies, Fine Art, Geography, Politics, DT Product Design, DT Textiles, Media Studies, Religious Studies and Sociology.

### BTEC level 3 entry requirements

To study **BTEC level 3 subjects** you need to achieve a minimum of 5 GCSEs at Grades 9-4 (or grade C and above) including either Maths grade 4 **and/or** English Language grade 4.

**BTEC National Extended Certificate in Applied Science:** A minimum of grades 44 in GCSE Combined Science or a Pass at BTEC Level 2 Science

There are no subject specific entry requirements for the following BTEC National level 3 subjects:

**Diploma:** Health and Social Care, Applied Science and Business

**Extended Certificate:** Creative Digital Media Production, Health and Social Care, Information Technology, Performing Arts, Music, Applied Science and Sport

There are no subject specific entry requirements for the Applied Diploma in Criminology
