BE READY:

Learning

- Ensure that my child attends school in the correct uniform, arrives on time and is properly equipped.

- Discuss my child's schoolwork and homework with them every day.
- Alert the school of any special circumstances which may affect my child's learning.
- Adhere to the school's PHSE curriculum.

- Attend consultation evenings and discussions about my child's progress.

Communication/General

- Regularly check the Satchel One app and the SIMS Parent App, to monitor my child and support the school.
