

Two -year technical courses equivalent to three A levels



GCSE / A Level

GCSE and A level qualifications are available in many different subjects.



Foundation learning courses combine practical and vocational experiences with basic maths, English and ICT. This is for learners not ready for a full level 2 qualification.



Apprenticeships offer training for a job while working with an employer, alongside study for an associated qualification. You get paid while working.
