Year 11 Parent – Teacher Consultation Evening
Wednesday 14th January 2026, 4:30pm – 7.30pm (in school)

On Wednesday 14th January, teachers will be discussing your child's academic progress with you, and the next steps to be taken to ensure success in the summer exams. **These appointments will be face to face meetings in school.** You will receive electronic copies of your child's Autumn Term Monitoring Report and mock exam results via the MCAS app on Wednesday 17th December. These reports will form the basis of your conversations.

The school is using an easy-to-use online appointment booking system. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments. Five minutes will be allocated for each slot, and we would appreciate your co-operation in keeping to the allotted times.

We expect you to make appointments to meet with all your child's subject teachers.

Parents and carers of selected students will be invited to arrive 10-15 minutes before the start of the evening in order to attend a brief meeting with one of the Deputy Headteachers or Mrs Manderson, Headteacher to discuss the results of the mock exams and receive guidance and support on how to ensure your child makes the best progress possible in the coming months. Parents and carers who are invited to attend will receive further communication about this at the start of the Spring Term.

Students must be present at appointments in **full and correct school uniform** with their parents/carers. This provides the opportunity to become further involved in the process of self-evaluation and review following the mock results and enables staff to highlight student achievement as well as any areas of concern, which may need addressing.
