**Who is the course for?**

The course will appeal to those students who:

- Have a keen interest in business and how it is operated.
- Enjoy studying a subject that is relevant to their own lives and experiences.
- Want to find out more about business through personal investigation.

**What can it lead to?**

Students that successfully complete their programme of study could progress onto a business related degree or Higher National Diploma. Previous Level 3 students have gone directly into employment in finance, administration and management, however, the majority go on to university.

**What are the entry requirements?**

At least 5 grade 4 GCSEs including Maths and/or English Language.

**What will I study?**

A BTEC National Diploma which is equivalent to two A Levels. If you complete 1 year, you get 1 A-Level equivalent, if you complete the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, you obtain another A-Level equivalent.

3. Three exams, set and marked by Edexcel
