## Who is the course for?

The course will appeal to those students who are interested in a career in business or those who would like to study business at third level.

## What can it lead to?

This is an excellent foundation for professional careers and higher education courses in Business, Finance, Accounting, Law, Marketing, Human Resources or Management.

## What are the entry requirements?

At least 6 grade 5-9 GCSEs including English Language and Mathematics.

### What will I study?

Students will study a range of topics that include: Business Resources, Business Environment, Marketing, Business Communication, Business Accounting, Human Resources, International Business, Internet Marketing, Business Economics, and Market Research.

### How will I be taught?

Through lectures, discussion, practical work (presentations/debates) and case studies.

#### How will I be assessed?

- 100% Examination

i.e. Equivalent to 1 A Level

Students will complete 3 exams at the end of year 13 each worth 33.3% of their final A Level grade:

Paper 1 (2 hours)

Paper 2 (2 hours)

Paper 3 (2 hours)

The new AS Level qualification for the first year teaching will not count to the final grade of an A-level but will be a stand-alone qualification in its own right
