



TO ALL PARENTS/CARERS OF STUDENTS SITTING PUBLIC EXAMINATIONS IN THE SUMMER 2023 EXAMINATION SEASON

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Rooks Heath School will be entering students as candidates for public examinations in the May-June 2023 examination season. This will include GCSE, A-Level, BTEC, Cambridge Nationals and Functional Skills examinations.

The Awarding Bodies (exam boards) and JCQ have decided to nominate the last day of the examination season as a **Contingency Day**, should an examination not be able to take place as timetabled "in the event of national or significant local disruption to examinations". *

For the 2023 Summer Examination Season this date is June 28th 2023.

We are therefore required to inform you that **all candidates must remain available to sit examinations until after that date**, should one or more of the Awarding Bodies need to invoke its Contingency Plan. Students would only need to attend School if the Contingency Plan is invoked and an examination is rescheduled.

Students who do not remain available until this date run the risk of losing their qualification should one or more of their papers be rescheduled up to and including June 28th and they are not available to attend at that time.
