Year 12 End of year arrangements

Year 12 End of Year Assessments

Year 12 End of Year Assessments begin on Monday 5th July and will run until Friday 9th July. For most qualifications, the last day of teaching for Year 12 is Friday 2nd July and students are not required to attend lessons, registration or tutorial after this date. Whilst I recognise how disrupted this year has been for Year 12 students, I cannot stress how important these assessments are. It is even more important these are completed in order to inform decisions on the suitability of student continuing in their current subjects into year 13. These outcomes will also form the basis of teachers' predicted grades for university applications as is usually done.

All assessments will take place in controlled conditions much like a public exam season. As most lessons are not running during this week students will have the time between exams to revise for their remaining assessments. Please encourage your child to revise as much as possible until they have completed all their assessments. When a student has completed their assessments, they do not need to attend school again this term. Students have been emailed a copy of the assessment timetable. Most assessments will take place in the Dance Studio and students must arrive 10 minutes before the start time of their assessment.

School laptops

Unless they have been given specific instructions by their teacher, students who have a school laptop need to hand their laptop back to IT Support **by Friday 2nd July**. Students need to make sure that they have no work solely saved on their laptop but saved in their Microsoft Teams / SharePoint folders.



A/AS level results day – 10am - 12pm Tuesday 10th August

This is a very important day for Year 12 students as, not only will they receive the AS level grade for any subject they were externally entered for, but they will also receive the results of their end of year assessments. Decisions will be made on this day regarding which subjects a student continues with into Year 13.

Start of Year 13 arrangements

Year 13 students return to school on Monday 6th September at 9am when they will attend an induction session with their tutors for one hour followed by their timetabled lessons.
