Safeguarding

<u>Internet Watch Foundation</u> – an independent charity that aims to help victims of child sexual abuse worldwide by identifying and removing online sexual imagery of under 18s, offering a place for the public to report suspected indecent images of children anonymously.

<u>Marie Collins Foundation</u> – a charity enabling children who have suffered sexual abuse and exploitation online to recover and live safe, fulfilling lives

National Crime Agency CEOP – a command of the NCA working with child protection partners across the UK to identify and eradicate threats to children

<u>Samaritans</u> – a suicide prevention charity with a 24-hour confidential helpline.

NSPCC – charity working to protect children and prevent abuse.

<u>Stop It Now!</u> – a child abuse prevention campaign and anonymous helpline for individuals worried about their own sexual thoughts or behaviour towards children or that of others.
