Dear Parents/Carers of Year 11 Students,

### Year 11 Mock Arrangements

Year 11 Mock Examinations begin on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> November and will run until Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. These are very important assessments that will help inform students, their teachers and you of how well they are doing in each subject. These grades will also be used to inform students predicted grades, with which they will apply to Sixth Form. You will receive a statement of results in the coming weeks.

All Year 11 students have received their [examination timetable](#) (details linked to this letter). We have supported students in their revision by running a Study Skills Day on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> October, and we would ask you to continue to encourage them to revise every day until the end of the Year 11 Mocks on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Students' GCSE exams will start from May 2022 (27 weeks away), and this is students' last full Mock Exam opportunity, so it is of the utmost importance they strive to do their best.

During the Mock Exams, we will have the following arrangements:

- Students with morning exams starting at 9.00am should go straight to the gyms at 8:50am.
- Students who do not have morning exams should go to tutor time as usual at 8:50am.
- All Year 11 students are welcome to use the Library or the Rookery (where students will also be able to purchase breakfast) to revise. The Rookery and the Library will be open 8:30am-8:50am.
- Students will not have their usual morning break, but may consume food or drink (at their teachers' discretion) in their period 2 lesson following their morning exams.
- Students must attend all of their exams promptly and be ready to start.
- Students must attend their usual lessons when they do not have an exam timetabled. Teachers will be supporting students to revise during these lessons, and teachers may direct students to do independent revision or specific revision for their subject. In vocational subjects students should expect to continue with their normal coursework.
- Students who have an afternoon exam will finish school at the end of their exam.
- Students who do not have an afternoon exam will finish their school day at 2:45pm and will be dismissed off site at that time. If a student's exam is still taking place at 2:45pm, then students will be dismissed after their exam finishes.
- Booster lessons will not be happening during the Year 11 Mocks.


