Year 7 on Class Report & Extra Curricular PE Clubs

I hope this letter finds you well and that you and your child has begun to settle into life at Rooks Heath School. I would like to thank all parents and carers who have encouraged their child to behave in line with our expectation to 'Strive to be their Best' and helped them with their transition into secondary education. It will make all the difference as they move forward. I hope this letter will be both informative and act as a reminder to you and your child.

Behaviour

Unfortunately, we have seen a small number of Year 7 students not meeting our expectations with regards to appropriate behaviour inside and outside of the classroom. This is disappointing and will not be tolerated. I am confident that all our parents want us to have a zero-tolerance approach. Parents, carers and students want a school environment which is safe and allows their child to be happy, thrive and succeed.

I have placed all Year 7 Tutor Groups on a class report, which informs their Form Tutors of those who are achieving highly and those who are a concern. Please expect Form Tutors to be in contact with you, should your child become a concern. Please also see the Link Book for the different forms of Report your child could be placed on to support their learning. We are counting on you both at home and outside school hours to reinforce our expectations.

Equally, if your child is achieving well, they will be awarded 'On Track' points, which also contribute towards our Bronze, Silver and Gold awards. To gain each 'On Track' badge, students must gain 25 points in each respective category. To gain their Bronze, Silver and Gold badges, they must earn 50, 125 and 250 points respectively. We will have an awards assembly after each half term where these badges will be presented.

Extra-Curricular PE Clubs

It is fantastic to see so many students wanting to be a part of our PE extra-curricular provision. Below is a table of PE clubs for your child to attend, both before and after half term. Clubs will run from 1515hrs – 1615hrs. After half term fixtures between Harrow schools will be taking place for both boys and girls, and if your child is selected to represent the school a letter from the PE teacher will be forthcoming.
