LION KING THEATRE TRIP - LYCEUM THEATRE, LONDON TUESDAY 25TH APRIL 2023

I am pleased to advise you that we are organising a theatre trip to see The Lion King for 6th Form students who are interested. We are currently expecting to take in the region of **80 students**, possibly more if there is the demand. The aim of this trip is to provide sixth form students and staff with an opportunity to socialise and bond with each other in an enjoyable and relaxed atmosphere. It provides students with the rare opportunity of a discounted theatre ticket whilst promoting student well-being and developing independence and a sense of community belonging.

All students will be responsible for their own tube fares. Attending students will be accompanied by members of staff from the Sixth Form team. Numbers of staff will be dependent on final number of students in attendance. We will meet at Rayners Lane tube station at 6.00pm and travel as a group to the venue, by taking the underground to Covent Garden station. The theatre showing starts at 7:30pm.

The cost of this trip is £25.50. There are several food outlets available at the venue along with first aid facilities if required. Students are advised to allow time to eat after school before meeting at the station.

In the unlikely event of any unforeseen circumstances arising which prevents us from attending, the students will be dismissed, and they will be able to spend the evening in London if they wish. As the party consists of mature students, they will be responsible for making their own way home from the venue. The school expects everyone to behave in a mature and orderly manner as they return but, as the students will not be supervised, the school cannot be held responsible for students on their return journeys. The running time of the show is 2 hours 30 minutes and so students will be dismissed from the theatre at approximately 10pm.
