Remote Working

After nearly three years of pandemic-adjusted working patterns, some workers are being called back to the office across some sectors. However, there are some jobs resisting.

Top sectors for remote working overall

Across the UK, 12.1% of all UK job vacancies were advertised as 'remote' in January 2023, compared to 11.3% labelled as 'hybrid' and 8.5% as 'on-site'/'office-based'.

The top sectors advertising for remote working roles overall remain IT (27.9% of job ads), Admin (21.7%), PR (20.4%), Teaching (16.5%) and HR & Recruitment (16.1%).





Eligibility Criteria:

- *Training is free if you are aged 19+ with proof of Right to Work in the UK, in receipt of one of the four main benefits: Job Seekers Allowance, Employment Support Allowance, Universal Credit, Income Support, and you or your spouse or a parent have been resident in the UK/EU/EEA for the last 3 years or more (except for the AAT Foundation Certificate in Bookkeeping and Functional Skills courses, where a £39.00 College Registration and ID fee is payable for everyone)
- You must be living in one of the London Boroughs
- If you are not working but not in receipt of any benefits, as long as you have the right to work in the UK, have lived in the UK/EU/EEA for 3 years or more (or your spouse or one of your parents has been resident for this period), your courses will be free (apart from AAT Bookkeeping, Functional Skills and ESOL, see above)
- If you are working, to be eligible for our free courses, those living inside the Greater London Area need to earn less than £21.547.50
- This evidence must be provided before any place on a course is confirmed. If you are not working but not receiving the above benefits, or if you are earning over the amounts above, a fee may be payable for these courses
- You will be assessed in English and Maths skills before a place on a course is confirmed
- Applicants for ICT and Business Administration courses will be asked to complete an ICT assessment

For the Level 2 Online Courses additional eligibility conditions apply - please ask for details

- If you are aged 19-23 you would be fully funded if you have previously achieved a full level 2 and are unemployed. If you do not meet both these criteria, you are not eligible for our funding
- If you are aged 24 + you would be fully funded if you are unemployed whether receiving benefits or not.
- If you are working but earning less than £21,547.50 per year, are aged 19 23 and have achieved a full Level 2, you will be fully funded
- If you are working but earning less than £21,547.50 per year and are aged 24+, you will be fully funded
