**Notice of Strike Action by Teacher Unions – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> & Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March**

I am writing to confirm with you our arrangements for Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March & Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March:

- All classes with teachers who are striking will not have lessons for the day.
- Any classes with teachers who are not striking, students will need to work from home with set tasks from these teachers, where possible on Satchel One and Teams. If there is no access to IT, we have asked these teachers to ensure students are given access to work they can do offline.
- Some Year 11 students have been invited to subject-specific sessions on Wednesday and/or Thursday where it has been possible to run these. Students will have received invites from their teachers and should be in school for the times indicated on their invite letter.
- Special arrangements will also be made for students with specific contexts. The safeguarding team will organise this on a case-by-case basis.
- All KS5 students may continue independent study at home.
- Any students that are on site and in receipt of a free school meal will have access to this. Students will need to be on site at 12:30pm in full school uniform and will be dismissed at 1:10pm.

Please note that this means that for these days, there may not be work set for every subject for every child. There may be periods of the day where students have no work set.

All members of staff who are not striking will be on site as normal.
