We are writing to inform you about the PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic) provision for Year 11 students on Thursday 30th March 2023. Students will be taken off timetable and receive a series of workshops delivered by KIP Education, an external agency. All groups will be supported by school staff in each session of the day.

KIP Education will cover the following topic areas on the day:

- Contraception/Pregnancy
- Consent and boundaries/Healthy relationships
- Mental health/Resilience
- Pornography/Misogyny
- LGBT/Equality/Inclusion
- Sexually Transmitted Infections

These topics have been chosen in line with the statutory guidance from the Department of Education and to ensure we fulfil our statutory obligations to enable our students to receive full coverage of all matters relating to Relationships and Sex Education and Health Education. All materials that will be presented will be reviewed by Rooks Heath staff prior to delivery.

The workshops will aim to inform and equip students with valuable life skills and knowledge which extend beyond the classroom, enabling them to make informed choices and live safe, healthy and productive lives.
