Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to you to let you know that we are bringing forward the date of Study Leave for all Year 11 students. Study Leave will begin now on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May. From Friday 19<sup>th</sup> May, students not in exams, will not be required to attend school. I hope that you will support your child in ensuring daily revision at least in line with school hours Monday-Friday when they are not in exams.

Students must then attend school at the time of their exams, 9am for a morning exam and 1.30pm for an afternoon exam. Students must attend exams **in full school uniform**. When students have a morning and an afternoon exam, these students should vacate the premises between the exams unless they have made other arrangements with Mr Parkinson. For health and safety reasons no student is to remain on site unsupervised.

Please go through exactly which dates your child needs to be in school to ensure they do not miss an exam. There will be no opportunities for students to catch up on any exams missed, and they will achieve a 0 (a U grade) for any exams they do not sit, and this will affect their overall average grade.

If students have arrangements with teachers to come into school to complete vocational work during those lessons, or to attend extra revision sessions, they may do so but must sign in at reception and sign out immediately after the session they have signed in for. In exceptional circumstances, if your child cannot be accommodated at home, please email Mr Parkinson and we will do our best to find a compromise.

Thank you for your support, we will continue to have encouraging conversations with our students as they take their exams and wish them the very best of luck.
