Sports Day – Additional Information

Students are to **arrive at school for registration at 8:45**. They will then walk down to the field in tutor groups and will be **dismissed from the field at approximately 1.00pm**. Students who receive free school meals will be allowed to have lunch in The Rookery at the end of Sports Day if they wish to. All other students will not be permitted to return to the school site at any time during the day.

Sports day is an inclusive day in which **all students** will have the opportunity to participate in a number of athletics and games events. All students should **come to school wearing their full PE Kit**. In addition, students must be prepared to take measures to protect themselves from the weather, e.g. sun bloc, shower proof clothing, hat etc. Students will need to bring their own food and drinks for the morning's activity.

In addition to the above, there will be a variety of activities held during the school day, for example, spelling bees, quizzes, extended tutor time and assemblies with complimentary breakfast.
