Special Playtimes	Qualified staff offer early intervention and support for parents of children pre & post diagnosis. This group offers the opportunity for you to learn tools to support your child's, care, learning & development with experienced staff. Great opportunities to develop communication tools & skills, to learn about behaviour triggers, routines, toileting, great home learning ideas, schemas and much more. The team can support signposting & referrals to services that will support you to meet your child's needs & to access your entitlement – booking only		
2 year old checks	Did you know that all 2 year olds are entitled to a health & development check. The Health Visiting Team provide part 1 (ASQ). If your child is in a setting they will carry out part 2 of the check. However if your child is not in a setting (nursery, childminder or school) then this can be carried out by a qualified Early Support team member) Great opportunity to learn ideas around how to support your child's next stage of development & to receive top tips & advice in areas you have questions		
Health & Well-being groups	A brilliant group to promote your child's health, an opportunity to learn activities that support building emotional resilience & intelligence, to learn healthy recipes & good games that promote healthy lifestyles & reduce the risks of obesity		
Outdoor play	Outdoor learning is essential in the Early Years, the outdoor play groups provide a great opportunity for exploration & learning (<i>especially for those that don't have an outdoor space at home</i>).
