It is our priority to maintain a uniform policy that contributes to a focused and respectful atmosphere within our school community. We want to remind you of our school's uniform policy, which includes specific guidelines regarding uniforms, piercings, hair colour, and footwear. These guidelines are in place to promote a sense of discipline, equality, and pride in our school identity.

Uniform Policy Overview:

1. **Correct Uniform:** All students are expected to wear the correct school uniform, including the appropriate attire for each day.
2. **Piercings:** Piercings are not allowed. Only one piercing per earlobe for small earrings is allowed.
3. **Hair Colour:** Students' hair colour should be within the natural range of colours. Unnatural hair colours are not allowed in any format.
4. **Footwear:** Students must wear the designated school footwear.

To maintain a consistent and fair approach, any student who attends school with incorrect uniform attire or breaches the rules on piercings, hair colour, or footwear **will be sent home**. They will be asked to return to school in the correct attire, adhering to our school uniform policy.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding in this matter and have confidence that you will have used the holiday time wisely to ensure your child is in the correct full school uniform.
