YEAR 11 SPRING MOCKS

On **Thursday 7th and Friday 8th March** Year 11 students will have their Spring Mock Examinations in Maths, English Literature and Religious Studies. This is a crucial set of Mock Exams as it is the final exam practice in exam conditions before the real set of exams which will start for most students on Thursday 9th May.

The Mock Exams will be as follows:

Day	Exam
Thursday 7: 9am	English Literature
Thursday 7: 1:10pm	Maths Non-Calculator
Friday 8: 9am	Religious Studies
Friday 8:1:10pm	Maths Calculator

Students will be able to make good use of the half term for revision, utilising the revision booklets provided.

For English Literature, students should focus on:

- Rereading An Inspector Calls
- Making mind maps about characters and themes from an Inspector Calls
- Learning key quotes linked to characters and themes
- Completing practice questions on both 'An Inspector Calls' and Unseen poetry using past papers and revision guides.

For Maths, students should focus on:

• Completing practice questions using targeted workbooks, past papers and topic worksheets which students can find in the mock revision folder in the Year 11 Maths folder on SharePoint.

For Religious Studies, students should focus on:

- We will focus on the two sections that you had lessons on this term: Christian Practices and Religion, Crime and Punishment. I have already put PowerPoints for these two sections on Satchel One. Download and use them as a revision resource.
- Revision books are still available to be purchased on ParentPay for £5.50.







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On the day of the exams, students should come to the Rookery at 8:50am and tutors will escort them to the gyms (or their allocated rooms) at 9am. On both afternoons, students will be dismissed from school when they finish their exam (approximately between 2:45pm and 3:30pm).

As usual for all exams JCQ regulations apply. Students are already well aware of the regulations, but these are shared here again for your information: <u>IFC-Written_Examinations_Sep2023_FINAL.pdf</u> (jcq.org.uk).

There are now twelve full teaching weeks in school remaining before the Year 11 Exams begin on 9th May. Please continue to encourage your child to work hard in lessons and to complete at least two hours of revision each evening.
