London Labour Market Update from GLA Economics – January 2024

Summary of key points

- The most timely estimate of **payrolled employees** (subject to revision) shows a decrease of around 2,610, in London between November and December 2023 and an increase of 1.0% on the year.
- Labour Force Survey (LFS) statistics are currently not considered reliable enough for publication. The ONS has instead released experimental "adjusted" estimates of the employment, unemployment and inactivity rates for the UK and the regions.
- The **adjusted employment rate** in London was estimated at 74.2% for the three months ending November 2023. London's employment rate was estimated to be lower than the UK average (75.8%).
- The **adjusted unemployment rate** in London was estimated at 5.3%. The UK average was 4.2%.
- London's **adjusted inactivity rate** (the measure of those not looking and/or not available to work) was estimated at 21.5%. This was higher than the UK-wide estimate of 20.8%.


The data provided in these reports cover a snapshot of the last month and include:


- Key employers who are recruiting in the area

In December 2023, there were 16,266 unique job postings in London.





Which job titles were advertised the most?


Which occupations had the most vacancies?

'n.e.c' stands for 'not elsewhere classified' and refers to jobs that are not categorised in any other 4digit SOC code.




Who is hiring and in which industries?

There were 16,266 job postings in the London area, but 3,062 records have been excluded because they do not include an industry. Therefore, the chart below is based on 81.13% of job postings and may not be representative of the full sample.




Which employers are hiring?
