TFL PROJECT GUARDIANS WORKSHOPS
Friday 14th June 2024

We are writing to inform you about an important initiative we are undertaking in collaboration with Transport for London (TfL) called Project Guardians. This program focuses on addressing and preventing sexual harassment on public transport.

Our goal is not to cause alarm but to equip and empower our young people with the knowledge and strategies they need in case they witness or experience sexual harassment while using public transport. The sessions are conducted in a sensitive and age-appropriate manner, ensuring that the students feel comfortable and supported throughout.

There will be 4, 1-hour sessions throughout the day with two tutor groups attending one session at a time. The aim is to increase their awareness of the different types of sexual harassment that can occur in a transport context. There is a strong emphasis on equipping students with the necessary knowledge to report these offences should they experience or witness them.

The typical content of these sessions includes:

- Examples of physical and non-physical forms of harassment, illustrated through real CCTV footage and media examples.
- A selection of recommended response strategies to use in various situations.
- Various methods of reporting sexual harassment, both within the school environment and externally.
- Information on where to access further support and resources.

We believe that by educating our students about these important issues, we can help create a safer and more supportive environment for everyone. If you have any questions or concerns about the content of these sessions, please do not hesitate to contact us.
