Dear Parents / Carers of Year 11,

GCSE RESULTS DAY

We would like to congratulate our Year 11 students on completing their exams and working hard throughout the GCSE examinations towards achieving their best.

Students will receive their GCSE results on the national GCSE Results Day, which will take place this year on Thursday 22nd August, and I am writing to inform you of the arrangements.

To collect results, Year 11 should arrive to the school E Block Gate between 8:30am and midday to collect their results from the main School Hall.

Students in Year 11 who are unable to collect their results on the day will receive their results the day after results day (Friday 23rd August) to their school email, so students should make every effort to attend in person on the day where students will have access to support and guidance regarding Sixth Form and next steps. The school is unable to hand over results envelopes to anyone other than the student, so students' siblings and friends are unable to collect their results for them.

If, after receiving their results, a student thinks their paper has been incorrectly marked, they can request a re-mark. However, the student will need to pay for the exam paper to be remarked and the mark may go down instead of up, so students should usually discuss this with their subject teacher before making a formal request. All loaned revision resources (such as textbooks and revision guides) should be brought back on results day. There will be a desk called 'Returns' to which they can bring their resources and have their names ticked off.
