Year 11 Mock Examinations – Important Information

We would like to inform you that Year 11 mock examinations will begin on **Monday, 17th November**, and will run for **just over two weeks**. A detailed timetable for the exams is shown below in this letter.

Mock examinations are a vital part of your child's preparation for their final GCSEs. These exams provide an opportunity to identify strengths and areas for improvement, and the **predicted grades for Sixth Form and college applications will be based on these results**. Therefore, we have strongly encouraged students to dedicate time to thorough revision to achieve the best possible outcomes.

During the mock examination period:

- Students will **start school at the normal time of 08:45** each day.
- Phones will be collected and handed out in the normal way.
- Students will follow their normal daily timetable when not in an examination.
- **Punctuality is essential** – arriving late may result in missed exam time.
- Students will finish the school day as normal.

Please note the following exam regulations:

- **No smart devices, jewellery or watches** are permitted in the exam hall. These items must not be brought into the examination room.

Additionally, please support your child in becoming familiar with the JCQ (Joint Council for Qualifications) regulations, which govern all public examinations. These rules are designed to ensure fairness, integrity, and security during exams, and we apply the same standards for our mock examinations. The regulations cover important aspects such as exam conduct, prohibited items (including mobile phones, smart devices, and watches), and the consequences of any breaches.
