

ACCESS+

As an **Access+** student, you'll have access to support such as:

- **Access+ Offer** - Contextual offer of up to two grades below the standard A Level entry requirements
- **Access+ Travel Bursary** - for open days and offer holder days
- **Access+ Team** - dedicated team on hand to answer your questions
- **Access+ Live** - expert help and guidance sessions online to support you in your journey to higher education

You'll need to have made Sheffield your **firm** choice with UCAS for the opportunity to apply for:

- an **Access+ Mentor** in July and August before you start Uni
- our **Access to Sheffield Scholarships** must have accepted your offer from Sheffield (firm or insurance) by Wednesday 6 May 2026

If you miss the conditions of your offer we'll still give your application additional consideration on Results Day.
