Thursday 30th April – Shirt Signing

Friday 1st May – Formal Day and Final Assembly

Our Formal Day and Final Assembly takes place on Friday 1st May. Students are expected to attend in **formal wear** and are invited to the Rookery for their complimentary Leaver's Breakfast at 8.15am, where they will be able to socialise, take photos with their friends and staff, before attending their final assembly in the hall. The extended assembly should finish at approximately 11.15am, after which students will be dismissed from School.
