**Re: Trip to Chessington World of Adventures Resort, Chessington, KT9 2NE
Tuesday 14th July 2026**

We are delighted to inform you that we are planning a trip to Chessington World of Adventures Resort for students in Year 7 on Tuesday 14th July. This trip is part of our end of term activities week and is a chance for our students to wind down, have fun, and celebrate the end of the school year. This trip will provide students with an invaluable and enjoyable experience.

We expect to take a group of up to 110 students, and we will be travelling by coach. We will leave promptly at 9.00am and ask that you ensure your child is ready to meet in E Block playground by 8:30am. We expect to return to Rooks Heath School at approximately 5:00pm where students will be dismissed and allowed to make their own way home. In the unlikely event of any unforeseen circumstances arising, which prevent the activity taking place, the group will return to the school. **Please note, we reserve the right to refuse a student's participation in an off-site activity where their current behaviour fails to meet the school's expectations and/or presents a health and safety concern. This is likely to include students who are on a behaviour report.**

Students can wear their own clothes which should be appropriate. Also, please ensure your child brings sunscreen and a hat in case of hot weather or a jacket in case of rain. Students are advised to bring a packed lunch and drink for the day or alternatively, they can purchase lunch at one of the outlets at the park. If students decide to purchase lunch, drinks or snacks at the venue, please ensure they have enough money with them to do so.

If your child is entitled to free school meals, we can arrange for a packed lunch to be provided by the school. Please [CLICK HERE](#) to complete a short form to indicate if a free school meal is required.

The cost of the trip is £40, which covers the cost of the entry fee and coach travel. Please note that if there is insufficient uptake for the trip, where we will be unable to cover the cost of it, we may be required to cancel it. In this event anyone who has paid will be reimbursed.

If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay via the Trips section on the MCAS app. Payment must be received by 19th June to allow the school sufficient time to plan the trip.
