Dear Parents / Carers of Year 7, 8 and 9 students,

**RE: YEAR 7, 8 AND 9 END OF YEAR EXAMS**

At the end of each year, we run End of Year Exams to assess students on what they have learned across the year. This encourages students to consolidate their learning and ensures students are ready for the next academic year of learning. In addition, the End of Year Exams help prepare students for the examinations they will sit in the upper school, which require them to revisit knowledge over time, and which must also be sat in silent, exam conditions.

The End of Year Exams for most subjects for students in Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 will take place from **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> June to Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June**. Classes in these Year Groups will have most of their exams in lessons according to their timetables, and the details of these End of Year Exams will be shared with students and parents on Bromcom by their subject teachers. English, Maths and Science exams will happen in the school gyms (where students go on to sit their GCSEs) so students get an experience of exam conditions. Students will sit their End of Year Exams in English, Maths and Science on the 16<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> June at the following times (and will attend their normal lessons otherwise on these days):

Please encourage your child to revise topics they have studied throughout the year at home, particularly during the half term break, and to use effective revision strategies and materials as shared at our Strive To Be Your Best Evenings (12<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> May).

As you may be aware, we assess students at least once per half term in every subject to monitor their progress. This assessment then feeds into students' termly Monitoring Reports which are sent home to inform you how your child is doing in school. Following these End of Year examinations, you will also receive a Monitoring Report detailing your child's progress in all subjects as of the end of this academic year.
