RE: Extreme Weather Update for Friday 26th June 2026

You will be aware I wrote to you on Tuesday 23rd June regarding the Met Office weather alert for very high temperatures and the measures we were putting in place to ensure students remained safe and comfortable whilst at school.

Given the continued Met Office weather warning for extreme heat, we have made the decision to adjust arrangements to include Friday 26th June as we did for Wednesday and Thursday this week to support the wellbeing of our students and staff.

Students will be dismissed at 12:35pm after phone collections have taken place. Students who can make their own way home will be permitted to leave as usual. If you are collecting your child, please make a note of the time. Any trips, masterclasses, detentions and clubs scheduled during this period will be cancelled and rescheduled where necessary.

We will continue to maintain our usual high expectations of behaviour and conduct. Students are expected to behave calmly and sensibly, both in school and when travelling to and from school. As temperatures are expected to fall over the weekend, school will resume as normal next week with full days. We would like to ask that you ensure your child returns wearing full school uniform.

Thank you for your understanding, cooperation and support as we work together to ensure the wellbeing of all students and staff during this period of exceptionally hot weather.
