As part of our Activities Week, we will be holding a picnic in Newton Park, Harrow. The picnic is scheduled for Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July, and we will provide all students entitled to a free school meal with a packed lunch. Students are also welcome to bring their own snacks and drinks, balls and games to play whilst at the park. We will offer a variety of sandwich options, so please ensure your child selects an appropriate option, keeping in mind any dietary requirements or allergies they may have.

We will walk to and from the park via Kings Road, departing from approximately 10:15 am. Following the picnic, students will be dismissed directly from the park at 12:35pm.

We expect all students to adhere to the school's behaviour expectations during this event. We aim to create a memorable experience for our entire school year on year. Please be aware that any failure to follow the behaviour for learning policy may result in students being denied participation in future activities. Additionally, we reserve the right to refuse a student's participation in off-site activities if their current behaviour does not meet the school's expectations or if it poses a health, safety or safeguarding concern. However, we would hope to include everyone in this celebratory activity without having enacted this policy.

Please note that we inform the local authority and the police about this off-site whole school activity and we will have a police presence to ensure the safety and vigilance of all at some point during the morning.

We are sure you will agree that it has been very hot recently and this weather is sure to continue. Therefore, please equip your child with adequate refreshments, a sun hat and sun cream as required so they are comfortable for the day. We hope the weather will be on our side. Should we experience heavy rainfall, students will remain on site, and the activity will be adapted to covered areas of the school including classrooms and / or larger indoor spaces.
