### Clarification of PE Uniform Requirements

As you are aware, we previously advised on the days your child is scheduled to have PE, **they must come to school wearing their full PE kit** and remain in this for the whole day.

At a minimum, students should wear the Rooks Heath polo shirt and Rooks Heath shorts or tracksuit. As students will be in PE kits all day, your child may wear plain tracksuit bottoms (not leggings) over their Rooks Heath shorts if they do not have Rooks Heath tracksuit bottoms. **Hoodies will be strictly prohibited** (except All Star hoodies). Branded sweatshirts are also **not permitted** to be worn. Students should wear their school coat over their polo shirt in cooler weather.

We have high expectations of our students and therefore any student wearing incorrect PE uniform items will be challenged at school. We may need to phone you to ask you to bring in correct PE uniform for your child to wear.

Students who refuse to wear or adjust their PE uniform to our regulations will face a sanction as per our Behaviour for Learning Policy. In only the most exceptional circumstances will we accept a reason from parents or carers who must call the school.

I know that you will support us in upholding our PE uniform procedures and I would like to thank you for your continued support during these challenging times.
