YEAR 10 ONLINE PARENT – TEACHER CONSULTATION EVENING
Tuesday April 27th 4pm – 8pm

On Tuesday April 27th, you will have the opportunity to speak to your child's teachers about your child's progress and the next steps to be taken to ensure continued success. You will have already received an electronic copy of your child's monitoring report via the SIMS Parent App and this will form the basis of your discussion.

Due to the current situation, appointments will be conducted via video. The school is now using an easy to use online appointment booking system. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments.

Students should attend appointments with parents/carers as this provides the opportunity to become further involved in the process of self-evaluation and review. It enables staff to highlight student achievement as well as any areas of concern, which may need addressing. Please note that teachers will not meet with any students without a parent or carer present.

Booking for appointments can be made from **6pm on Monday 29th March and will close at 10pm on Monday 26th April.** Appointments are limited to 5 minutes in length. If you have a need to discuss something beyond the 5 minutes you will need to make a telephone appointment with the teacher at another time.

Some teachers teach a lot of students in Year 10 and so will be particularly busy and may become fully booked in which case you will be able to join the teacher's waiting list. If an appointment does not become available, we will arrange a telephone consultation over the coming week after parents evening.
