A series of events are being conducted on behalf of the University of Oxford aimed both at students interested in the university and those who would like to develop their interest in a particular subject.

A new range of subject specific taster lectures are available which aim to introduce students to what studying a particular subject may be like at university level. Each talk will be delivered using Microsoft Teams and includes a Q&A. Talks include:
